



**The Weald CofE Primary School Remote Learning Plan**

**Introduction**

The key principles of The Weald's remote learning follows our approach to teaching and learning. This includes revisiting prior learning, giving a clear purpose and guided practice through modelling/scaffolding and feedback. It is essential at The Weald's that what children are learning at home aligns with what is being taught in school - pupils will be set work to do at home that gives them opportunities to practise what has been covered in the classroom. Pupils who do not have digital devices will be able to borrow a device from the school. In the case of children self-isolating, the school will record lessons in the classroom, which will be uploaded onto each year group's Google Classroom for the following day. In the case of a bubble closure, teachers will record lessons remotely and upload these to Google Classroom. The Whole School Classroom will continue to offer a broad and balanced curriculum, which will include Collective Worship and Celebration Assembly.

**To enable teaching and learning to continue as effectively as possible during the need for remote learning:**

- We will make daily contact with parents via Google Classroom. This could be in the form of a typed message or a short, pre-recorded video.
- We will not use live lessons but provide frequent and clear explanations of new content using high quality resources and pre-recorded videos.
- Children have access to Multiplication rockstars
- Monitor the phone logs to ensure families are called regularly and any issues are followed up
- Monitor the engagement of pupils learning.
- Communicate regularly with families through Newsletters and phone calls and parentmail.

**Our staff will:**

- Provide a weekly timetable for pupils.
- Daily learning activities and tasks will be shared on Google Classroom in the children's year group area and whole school activities, worship and wellbeing in the Whole School Google Classroom.
- Provide feedback to pupils whilst they are working at home.
- Check the register and monitor work submitted by pupils
- Communicate with each pupil frequently through our Google Classroom platform.

**Our pupils/students will be expected to:**



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- Complete the learning set by their teacher each day with a minimum of English/Maths and one other subject and upload their learning as requested by the teacher – photograph/video/google document or complete in their home learning book/work book to be marked when back at school.
- Read their book each day. All children have access to reading books
- Talk with their friends through the Google Classroom.
- Use online resources such as Rockstars and any other resources provided by the school.

#### **Parents are responsible for:**

- Set a clear routine with each child using the timetable and the daily learning set.
- Read all communications that come out from the school to ensure they are fully aware and up to date with news.
- Support their children to complete all of the learning set.
- Liaise with school staff and seek support on behalf of their child when needed, with class teacher via Google Classroom or through the school office.
- Support their children by uploading the work onto Google Classroom, ready for assessment and feedback.

#### **How to access work:**

Children will need to log onto their class portal on Google Classroom. Children have a log in for Google Classroom and TT Rockstar. We also have a helpdesk email: support@.....

#### **Vulnerable and Key Workers**

In light of a bubble or whole school closure the school will be open for Key Worker children and vulnerable children. They will be placed into Bubbles with 2 consistent members of staff. They will complete all remote learning set by their class teachers on chrome books or computers provided by the school.

#### **Communication**

We will communicate via parentmail with letters, text and email updates and daily telephone calls.
