Admissions

The Weald (CofE) Primary School can admit 34 children into Year 3 each year. Places in Year 3 should be applied for either online from Surrey's website www.surreycc.gov.uk/schools-and-learning/schools/school-admissions or the school's website www.wealdprimaryschool.co.uk or in hard copy from the school office. Children are admitted into Year 3 in the September after their 7th birthday.

Learning Environment

Our school is set in 17 acres of beautiful grounds and woodland. Children, staff, parents, carers and the wider community use these for sport, for studying the environment or for simply enjoying the space to grow and learn. We have 6 KS2 classes with specialist library, Music and ICT areas. We have computers, laptops, iPads and Chromebooks, all of which are networked and connected to the Internet. Staff guide children in the library and develop their skills and knowledge in Music and ICT. All children, from our youngest to our oldest, have the opportunity to use these facilities each week.

Our School Family

When your child joins our school they automatically become part of our family and the wider community in Beare Green and Holmwood. The staff and all those involved in governance at The Weald give the highest priority to children’s emotional and social well-being coupled with the high quality of teaching and learning within the school. They are committed to providing high quality resources to deliver this. All classes have support from teaching assistants. The progress of children is carefully monitored across all aspects of learning including personal, social and emotional development.
