Weekly spellings: Spelling lists will be issued on a Friday and tested the following Friday. The spellings will link to the spelling patterns being taught in class and/or incorporate the Year 1-2 Common Exception Words or 3-4 Words. Please encourage your child to practise their spellings each evening.

Our enquiry: WHAT SHOULD WE FLUSH DOWN THE LOO?



Enquiry: We are Scientists, Geographers and Engineer.

For this enquiry the children will be looking at water and plastic pollution. We will look at the science of classification and plant/animal habitats to reflect on how humans can impact on this – with a focus on us and what we do – specifically around water and plastics. Following this, we will do a second enquiry titled "Why are more people becoming vegetarian?". This will look at 'what and how plants grow', the digestive system, what happens to the food we eat and how our teeth have developed accordingly. As well as making some food too.

Maths: We are Mathematicians

This half term the children are revisiting the four operations and developing their number sense, through written methods.

We will be finding out good ways of learning our times tables.

How you can help at home? Help your child apply their maths in practical situations. Practice telling the time; counting with coins; talking about fractions when cooking/ baking.

Encourage your child to use the Times Table Rockstar App to learn their times tables and associated division facts.
